New Superyacht Marina Down Under: Rivergate Marina Brisbane Australia

The \$250 million Rivergate Marina will result in a 104-berth, deep-access marina for the widest range of boats, 15 minutes from Brisbane’s inner city, ten minutes from the airport and six nautical miles from Moreton Bay. The project is opening up in stages, with some of the marina berths open now. The 75-ton travel lift is expected to open mid-February; the 300-ton lift is scheduled for September. Also under construction is a

Refit Complex, consisting of 23 workshops surrounding the hardstand. This is expected to open in April. Rivergate is being constructed on a 15.24-hectare site purchased from the state government in June 2004. Murarrie Developments Pty, Ltd., a company associated with Adco Constructions Directors Bob Hill and Judy Brinsmead and Central Properties Corporations’ Stephen Gosling, is undertaking Rivergate.
